“Jennifer Alexander routinely goes above and beyond what is expected of a substitute teacher,” said Anthony Frazier, Principal at Warwick High School in Newport News, VA. “Between the respect she commands in the classroom, the way she’s developed relationships with full-time

faculty and the frequency she works, one could easily mistake her as a full-time teacher. We're honored to have someone of her caliber in our classrooms, and so are the kids she teaches."
